We are also working on increasing qualify and without the pressure of getting licensed because of getting finger printed. We are supporting more and more providers. The flexibility is more equity. How has the HUB been supportive? Jenna- the HUB is completely funding the Spanish speaking providers. When Miriam was here she was very helpful in connecting the Spanish speaking providers. As a region (Polk, Marion, Yamhill) and working together really strengthens and gives us more leverage. Kristina Sheppard: the HUB is the cross sector of Health, education, K12 and PLT. The depth of our conversations continues to cross over and says a lot about our leadership Suey: The CCO is now thinking about education and thinking about projects. With Head start we work with 7 school districts and I appreciate having all 7 at the table. Lauren Berg: connect w/ Head start when kids are coming to our school Russell: one interesting thing about the HUB is one of the few HUBs that integrates child education and childhood trauma.
