Hello Service Integration Partners,

Yamhill County Service Integration is partnering with Systems of Care to administer agile funding. Families do not have to be involved in systems of care to receive funding. You may start requesting funds on behalf of families you are working with as of today 7/5/2023. Funds will be available on a first come first served basis and they must meet the criteria below. Funds are available until they run out. We will be utilizing a new survey link for this specific grant: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/52R8FGV>

Agencies can request up to \$1,000.00 total per family and can submit more than one request per family, however, combined total cannot exceed \$1,000.00. For items such as food cards or gas vouchers, do not exceed \$100.00 per request. REFERRALS MUST COME FROM AN AGENCY. PRIORITIZING BY ORDER IN WHICH REFERRAL IS RECEIVED WITH A 2 WEEK TURN AROUND.

Please be mindful of shipping or processing fees, include these in the total amount. Payments will be made directly to the vendor or service provider. Payments are made by credit card or check. Please note that checks are the payment of last resort and a completed W9 must be obtained from the vendor/service provider and submitted to Service Integration (SI) Specialist for processing. If a vendor/service provider fails to accept credit card payment or issue a completed W9, payment cannot be made.

Clients must meet both of the following criteria:

- (1) Have children in the home or be working on reunification and needing funds to address items listed in their reunification plan. Children must be under 18.
- (2) Must be used to fund the following:
  - Housing Support
    - Rental assistance or temporary housing (e.g., rental payments, deposits, utility assistance)
    - Furniture, furniture delivery costs
    - Home modifications (e.g., ramps, handrails)
    - Pre-tenancy and tenancy support services (e.g., housing application, moving support, eviction prevention)
    - Housing focused navigation or case management
    - House cleaning services
    - Repairs related to damage by a youth in crisis
  - Food assistance
  - Protection from climate events
    - Payment for devices that maintain healthy temperatures and clean air, including air conditioners, heaters, air filters, and generators to operate devices when power outages occur
  - Therapeutic tools
    - Sand table
    - Sensory items
    - Weighted blanket
    - White noise machine
    - Noise canceling headphones
  - Item that both relieve family stress and give opportunity for positive skills practice
    - Zoo or museum passes
    - Aquarium or pool passes
    - Wellness activities including gym memberships, creative lessons such as art, karate, yoga, classes in leadership, or other pro-social development activities
    - Internet and Technology support
  - Items to support gender identity and sexual orientation
    - Gender appropriate clothes shopping
    - Haircuts and/or hair removal
  - Transportation assistance to appointments/activities
    - Bus pass or gas vouchers
    - Vehicle repair
    - Bike and bike repair

## **Volunteers Needed as Older Adults seek Nutritious Meals and Social Interaction**

*Congregate meal sites and meal deliveries not only provide food, but much needed social engagement for older adults*

**McMinnville, Or.** – In uncertain times, through heightened health concerns, supply chain issues, and rising inflation, NorthWest Senior and Disability Services (NWSDS) has continued to serve older Americans throughout Yamhill County. As the local Area Agency on Aging, NWSDS provides many services including Medicaid and assistance with mental health, wellness, and money management, but one of their most important programs is nutrition services.

A study published by Feeding America in April 2023<sup>i</sup>, found that 1 in 14 seniors in the United States age 60 and older was food insecure in 2021. That is roughly 5.5 million older adults in the U.S. and 6.9% of seniors in the State of Oregon. Programs like NWSDS's home-delivered meals, congregate meal services, and assistance in accessing SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) have been and continue to be vital in our communities. With the projected increase in the older adult population in the coming years<sup>ii</sup> as the Boomer generation ages and retires, these programs will become even more important.

From March 2020 through August 2022, NWSDS delivered over 153,000 meals to older adults in Yamhill County, ensuring hundreds of older adults continued to have safe access to nutritious meals throughout the pandemic. Adapting quickly, they provided meals for older adults and adults with disabilities in the community with contactless delivery and contactless pick-up options.

The home-delivered meals and meal pick-ups have meant more than just nutritious food for those in need, though. "For a lot of people we serve, these meals mean someone is coming to visit with them," said Sheridan Nutrition Site Coordinator, Carrie Brooks. "Often, they do not see other individuals, no visitors. You know, they're home alone. A lot of them engage in conversation because that's their social contact; they do not get out. Some of them do not have vehicles to even get out and do their own shopping. It's a lifesaver for a lot of them."

According to the CDC, loneliness and social isolation are linked to serious health conditions including increased risk of dementia.<sup>iii</sup> Having programs that provide spaces that are safe and engaging for older adults that have little or no cost are vital. The re-opening of the in-person congregate meal sites across Yamhill County provide social connection as well as opportunities to connect to other services and programs to keep older adults engaged.

These NWSDS nutrition programs are heavily dependent upon volunteers, and each site builds a little community. "I can't do my job without my volunteers and I appreciate each and every one of them. The folks we serve need help to get nutritious meals and appreciate everyone's efforts. We need you and they need you," says Michelle Guillory, the McMinnville Meal Site Coordinator.

NWSDS is hoping to re-open in-person meals for those who would like to dine together in Sheridan and McMinnville, but can't do so without volunteer assistance.
