

# Adolescent Well Child Care/HPV: A CME Event



## Session Objectives:

1. Define dysfunctional uterine bleeding and describe workup and treatment options.
2. Feel confident using contraceptive strategies for dysfunctional uterine bleeding and pregnancy prevention.
3. Review human papilloma virus and prevention with vaccination.
4. Utilize Motivational Interviewing as a strategy to address adolescent concerns such as obesity, diet and exercise, anxiety, depression, drugs and alcohol consumption.
5. Incorporate all the above to turn any adolescent visit into a “Well Child Check” while meeting the CRAFFT, diet and exercise discussion, effective contraceptive use.
