Funding Discussion: Part II	RFP Review Joint Funding Streams Request for Proposals application shared on screen Historical Context This Joint RFP was begun more than a year ago as part of an overarching goal to have a single RFP cycle and process for all of our different funding streams • To keep partners from getting confused when applying for grants • To put onus of administrative decision making around what application fits what specific funding stream best • Early Learning grants provided by the Early Learning Hub • Community Health Improvement Plan grants that the CAC decides on • Community Prevention and Wellness Fund which is evidence-based primary prevention programs • This year the joint grant application is ready and will be released in March The goal today is to get approval from this group on the combined RFP knowing that it is attempting to be inclusive of all of the funding streams.
