

# Community Health Workers

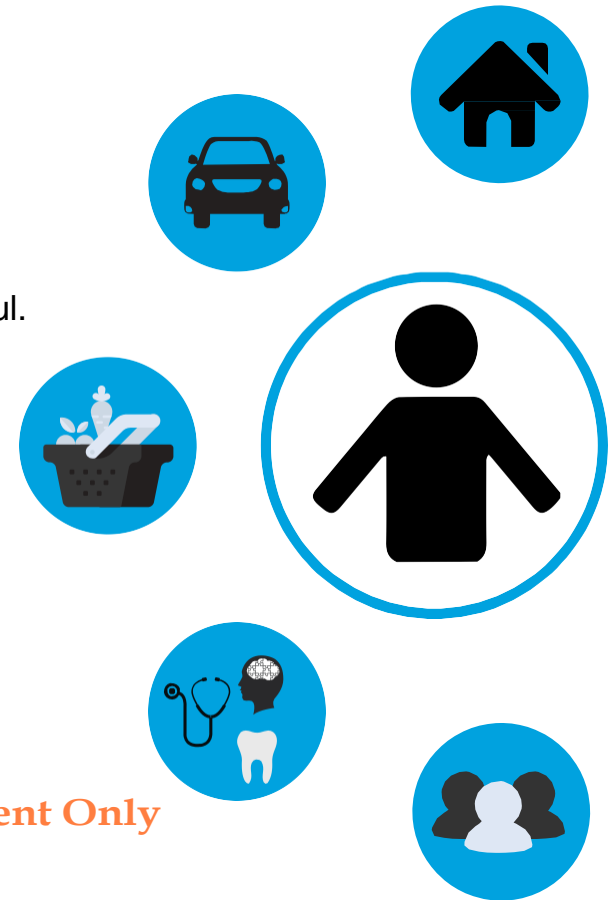
## What are Community Health Workers (CHWs)?

Community Health Workers (CHW's) are helpers who understand people's special needs. CHW's support YCCO members by finding community resources to help that person. They also connect people to social services or other people who can help.

- Tell members about their health benefits.
