Resident feedback requested to improve local programs and services

The survey allows community members to have a direct impact on programs and services offered and is part of a larger Community Health Assessment being conducted by YCCO in 2019 to help improve the quality of life of our residents.

"With this information we can make more informed decisions regarding programs and services that are most needed in the community."
